

A 'housewarming' present for 100 households from the Warm Zone

ONE hundred lucky families are set to receive a special 'housewarming present' from North Staffs Warm Zone (NSWZ).

NSWZ has just moved premises, from Hanley to a new base at Initiative House in Campbell Road, Stoke.

And to help celebrate the move, the project is offering FREE home insulation measures - subject to survey - to the first 100 people to write in to or email the project.

"The last time we made an offer like this, the response was absolutely overwhelming," said NSWZ Zone Director Sophie Thorley. "So much so that it brought our phone system down, which is why we're now asking people to write or email."

The first 100 people to contact NSWZ in writing, marking their entry 'NSWZ Housewarming', will be eligible for FREE cavity wall and loft insulation at their home - worth £300 for an average sized home - once a survey of their property has been carried out.

Added Sophie: "This special offer is only open to residents who submit entries in writing, because of the need to keep our phone lines free for our day-to-day work.

"But for the 100 winners, it will ensure they will be going into the winter in a warmer, more energy-efficient home, which is the central aim of the Warm Zone project."

NSWZ has installed in excess of 10,000 insulation measures in local homes - and its

Benefits Service recently passed the £1.5 million mark in uncovering and generating unclaimed entitlements for North Staffordshire people.

Every householder visited by the Warm Zone team in Stoke-on-Trent and Newcastle Borough has qualified for either FREE or cut-price cavity wall and insulation under NSWZ's ongoing energy efficiency campaign.
